We are happy that during these 21 years our Institution has succeeded in imparting quality and value based education to our students. So much so that it has claimed the top spot in Hassan district and has become a model school in the entire district. Our Institution has the distinction of one of the best schools in the State. It is a matter of pride that talented children of our school have participated in all the fields, be it in academics, sports, arts or cultural events and have come out with flying colours in District level, State level and even at National levels every year.

In SSLC Examination 2016, our students have shared II and III ranks in the State. Out of 180 students who appeared for SSLC examination, 64 students have scored 600 and above out of 625 marks. 103 students have scored centum marks in six subjects.

To create awareness about our precious environment among children and to cultivate moral values in the tender age itself, we conduct many programmes and activities every year.

Under RTE Act, 25% seats are given. Apart from this, free education is given to some needy meritorious students.

To acquaint our teaching faculty with changing methods of education, they are given periodic training.

Workshop for all the teachers on communicative English was conducted by Mr. Lenin from the Institute of Language Management Bengaluru in the month of May.

On 13/05/2016 and 14/05/2016 a workshop on life skills was held for all the teachers.
