


#### Dear Vijaya members,





## **Community services**

Serving our community has been a core aspect of our school. We believe that it is the responsibility of every individual to serve the needy and poor. Right from the early years we sensitize students for serving the community in various capacities. This year during the floods, all the Vijaya members felt the need to respond to the situation and distributed bare essential kits to the flood victims. We were able to raise the fund of rupees 1,50,000 with the support of parents, students and teachers. A team of students, teachers lead by Tara S Swamy and Subba Swamy visited the flood camps in August, 2019 at Bidarahally, Mudigere and Holenarasipura and distributed the kits to the needy. This experience reinforced the idea of service among students and teachers.

As an earth friendly school, our work in environmental conservation is worth mentioning. We have adopted few ponds namely Doddakondagula Ammakatte, Chikkahonnenahalli pond in our locality. We have planted and are still maintaining around 100 varieties of plants in these areas. In collaboration with the local NGOs and government departments we are able to bring a change in our own community.
