According to Rotary president Dr Tejwani, the collected books will be donated to public libraries and government schools in rural areas.

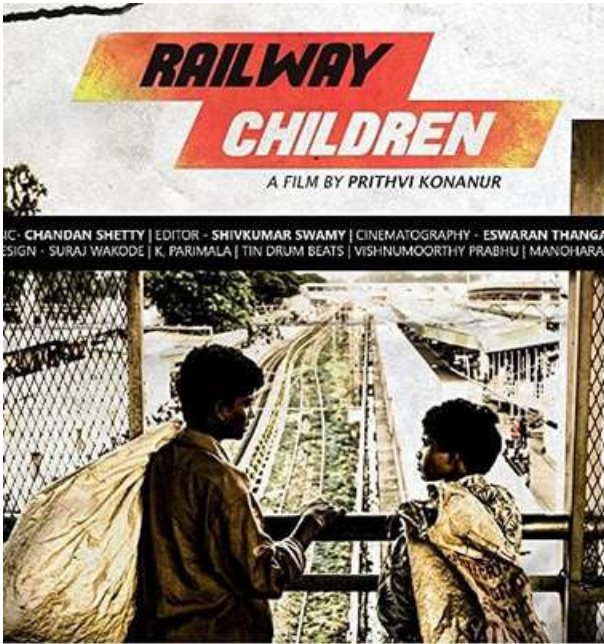
