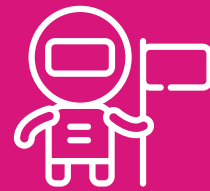

SCIENCE EXHIBITION, DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, HASSAN

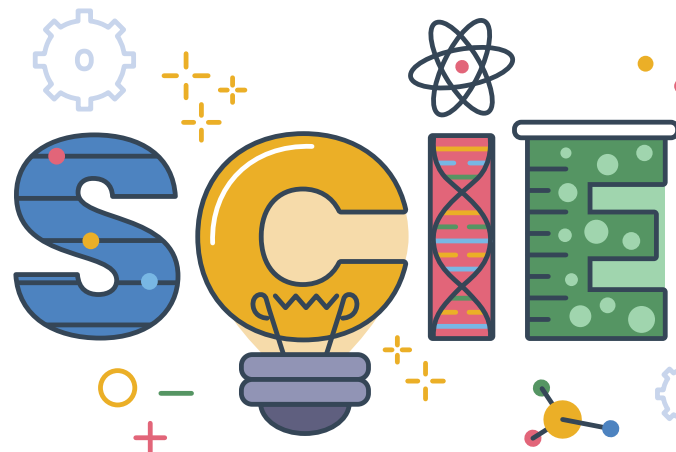

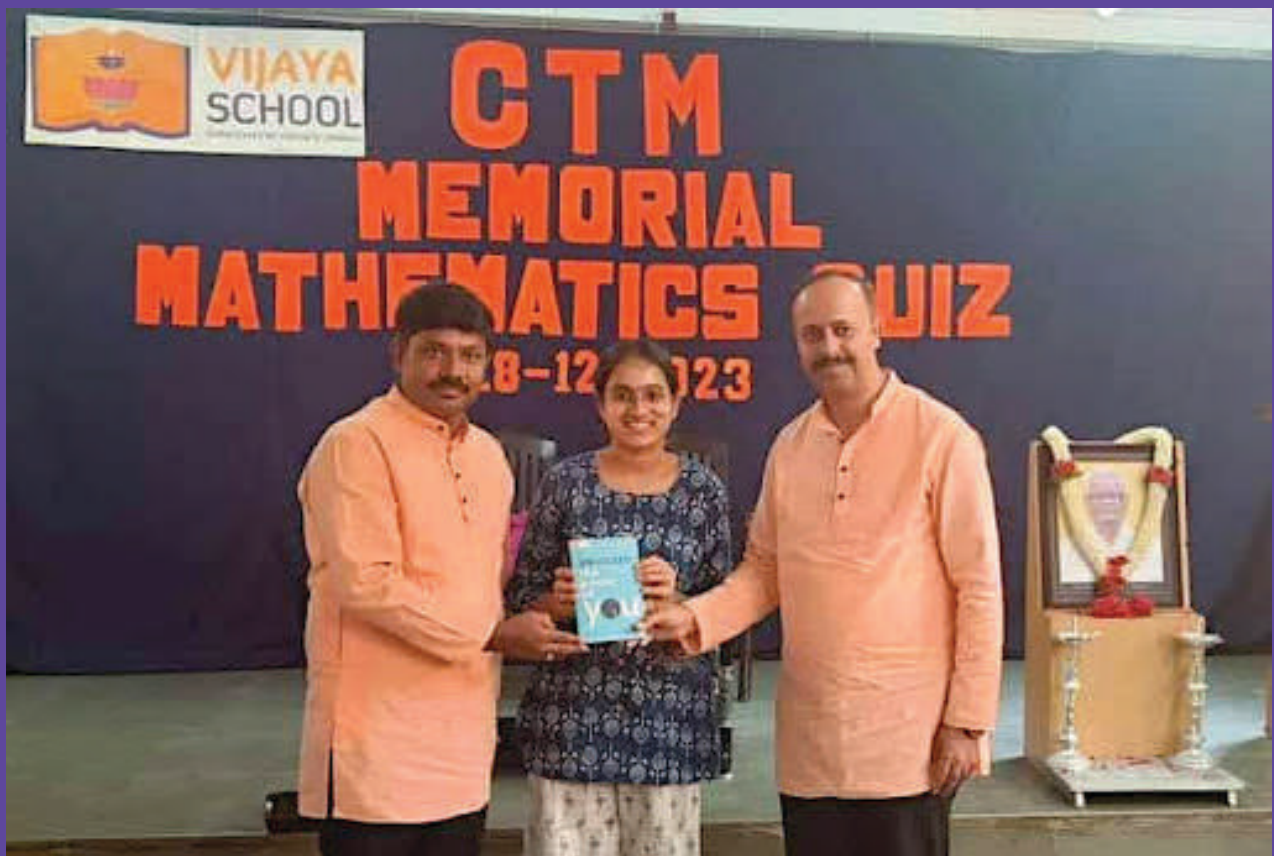
ELECTORAL DAY COMPETITION

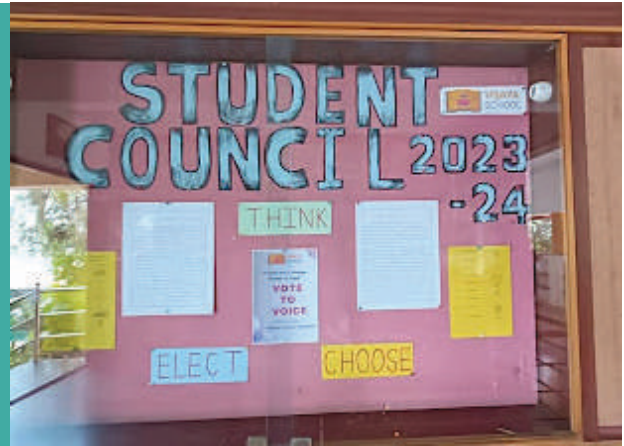
Student Council

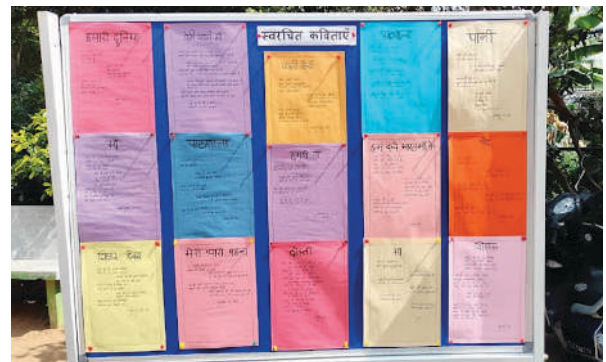

Exposure into the arena of research was yet another mighty leap forward in our quest for imparting education that empowers students to be independent thinkers and change makers.

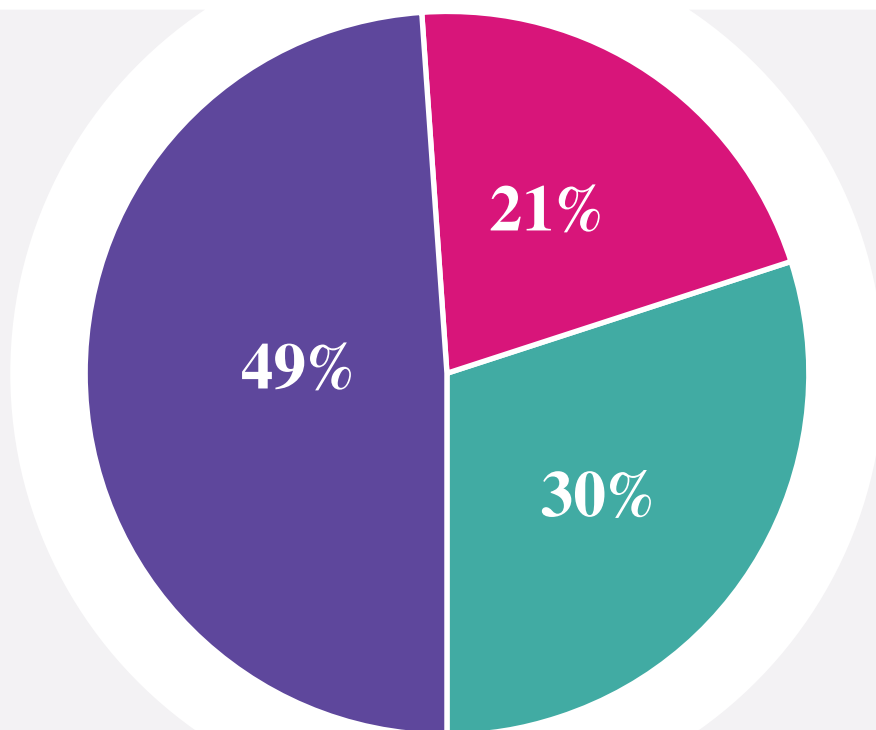

Additionally, it prepares them for academic and professional success by honing their research skills, analytical and communication abilities.

A study on students' career aspirations at the secondary school level

The first research was undertaken by two 10th-grade students, Hari Prasad K and Samruddhi V, focusing on the Career Aspirations of Students in Secondary Education. Engaging in a comprehensive research methodology encompassing problem identification, data collection, analysis, and presentation, the students dedicated 10 months to the project with fervor and methodological rigor. The forthcoming dissemination of their findings will include publication in newspapers and academic journals.

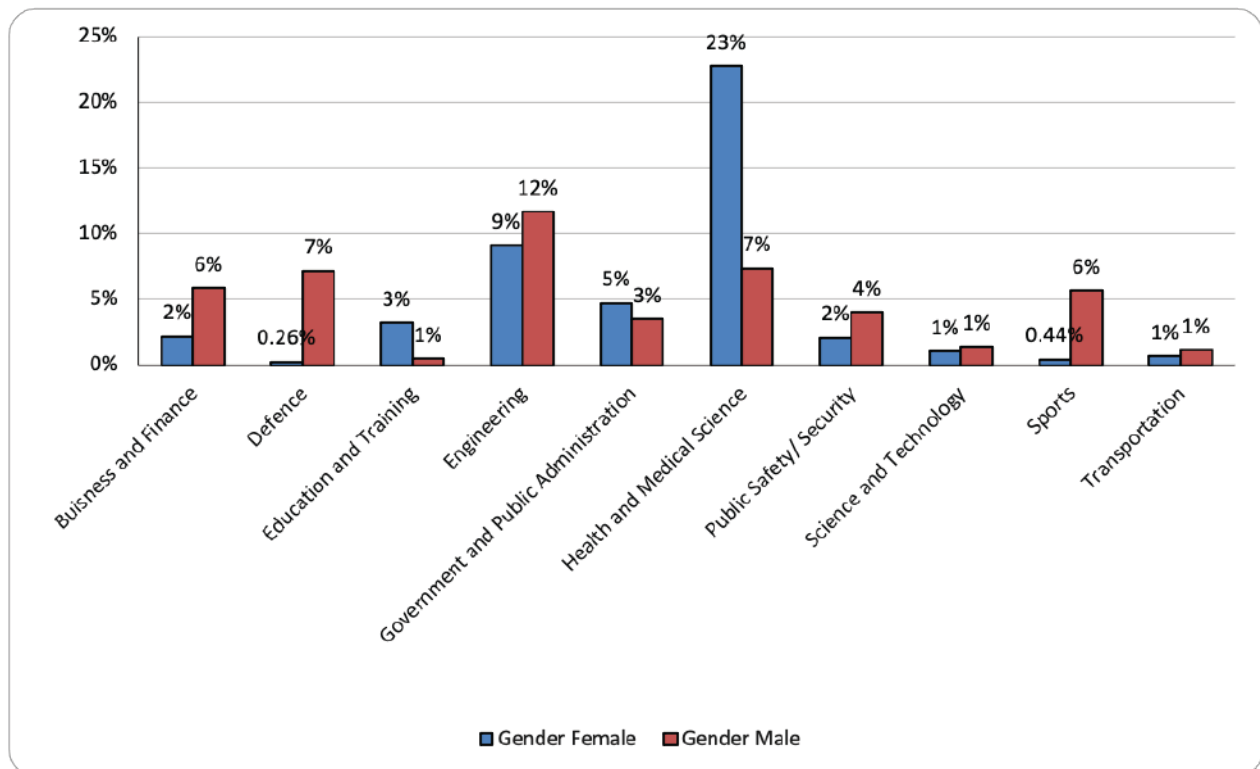
Medical & Engineering vs Others



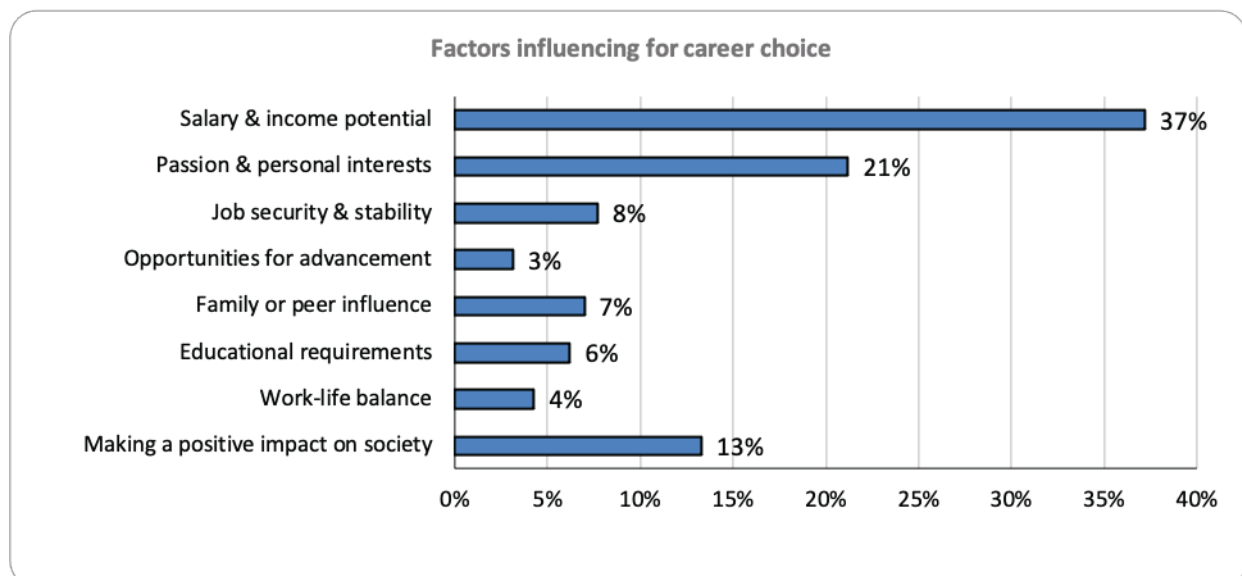
■ Health and Medical Science

About 50% of students aimed for careers in Medical Sciences and Engineering, while the other 50% had diverse aspirations like Business, Finance, and Public Administration being the most common.



A majority of female participants (23% of total medical 30%) favored Health and Medical Sciences, while male participants (12% of total engineering 21%) leaned towards Engineering.



Salary and income potential emerged as the primary influencing factors for career choice among most male students, whereas passion and interest held greater sway for female students.

SIA Talk Students In Action

SIA Talk series, a public speaking platform launched at school in 2023, provides a forum for students to hone their oratory skills and share ideas. It offers a conducive environment for participants to develop confidence, articulate thoughts effectively, and engage with diverse audiences. The initiative cultivates a culture of expression and intellectual exchange among students.

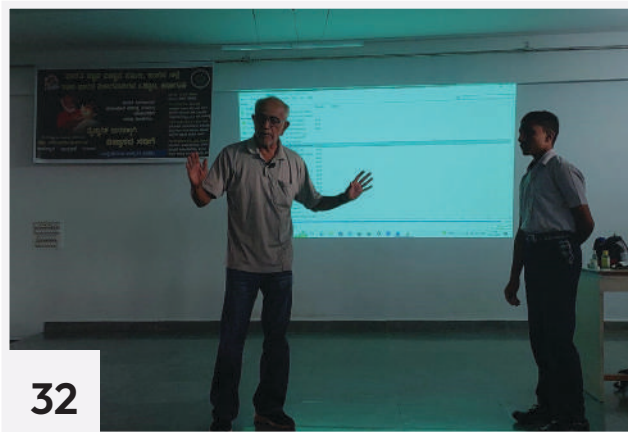
Mental Health & Stress Management And Digital Literacy

Our Students and teachers had a vibrant interactive session with Mr. Deek Parassini that helped reshape their perspectives about life and living and spread positivity.



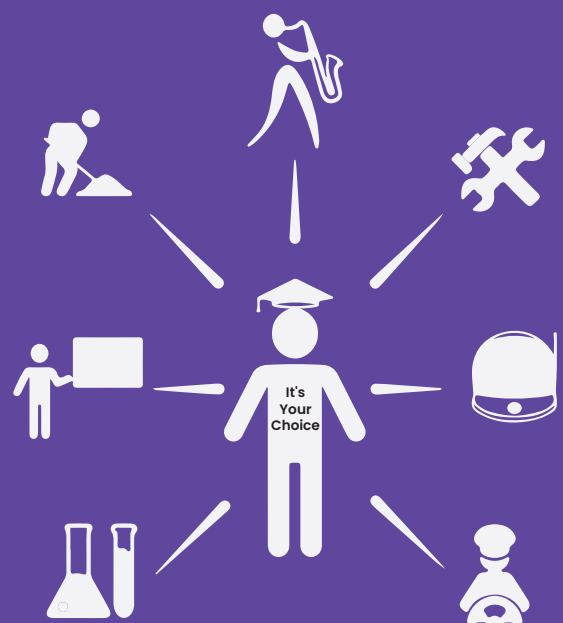
Gender Equity Session by **ENFOLD, Bangalore**

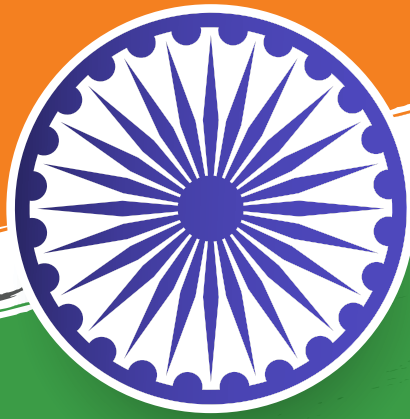

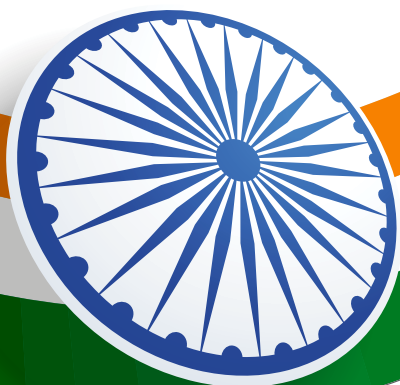


Republic Day

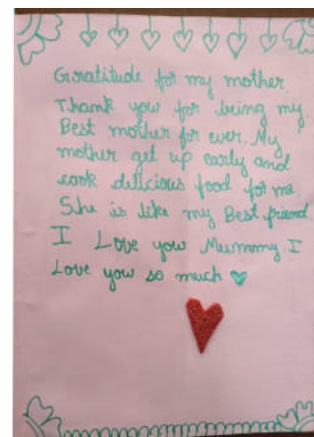
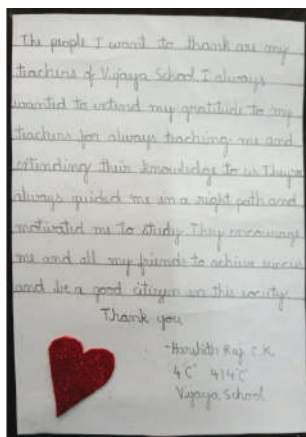
TEACHERS' DAY

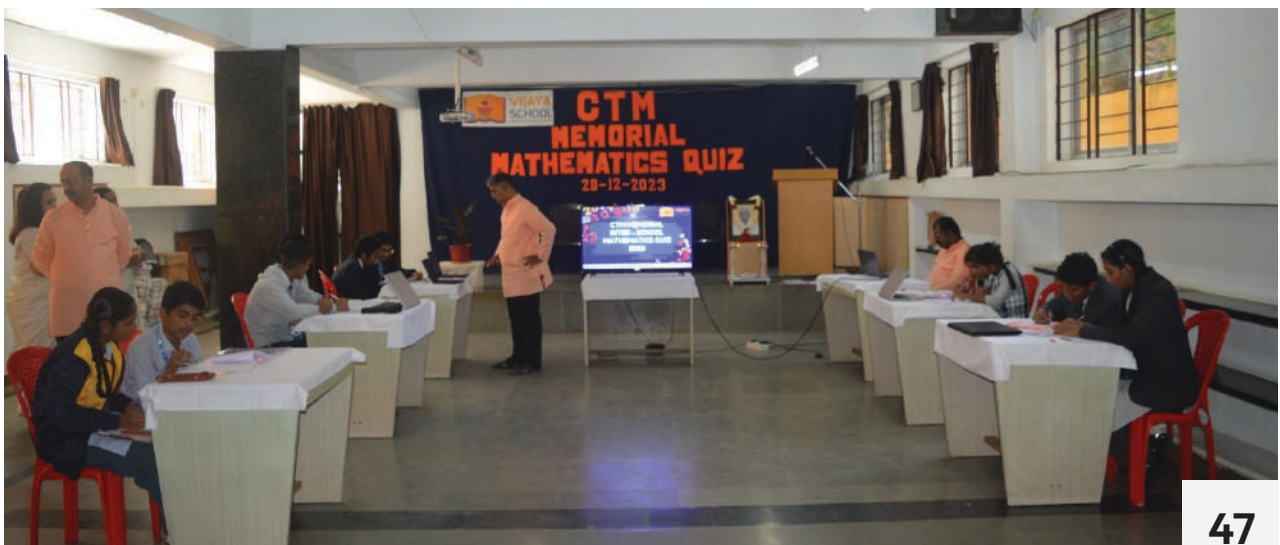

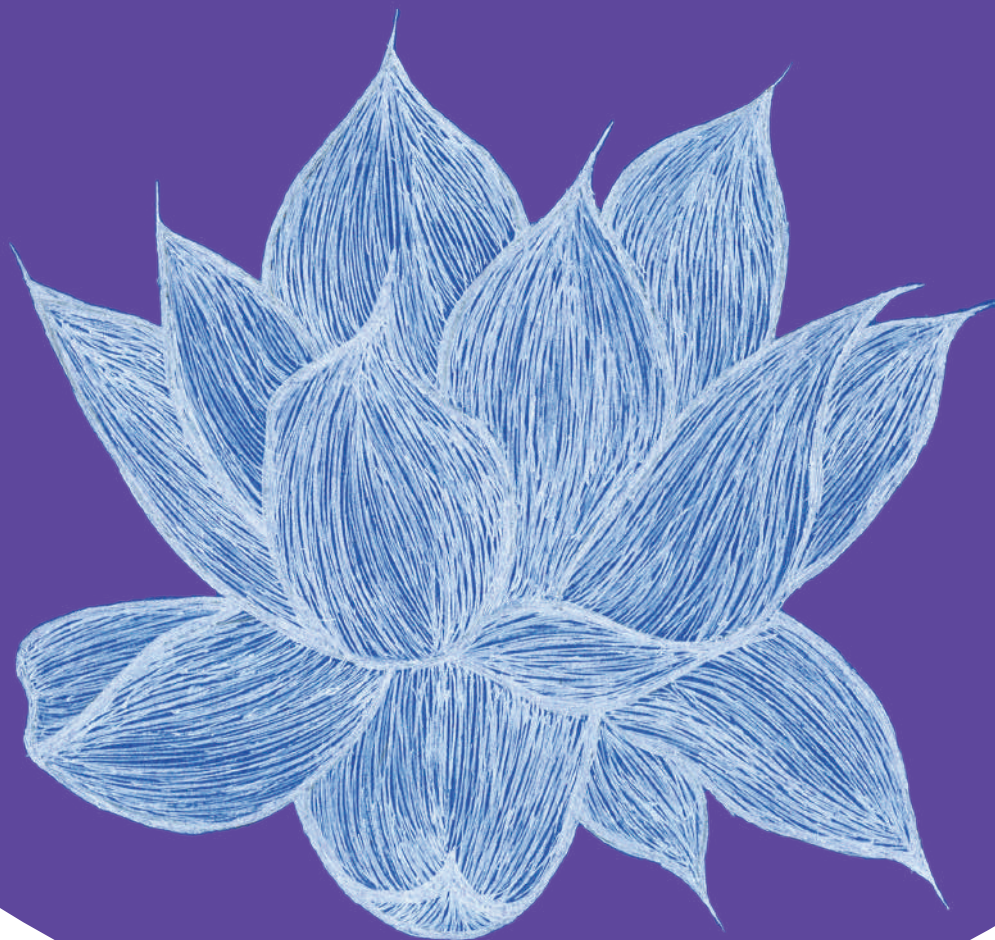
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
